



## Nick Satterfield

May 27, 1957 - February 13, 2021

Mr. Curtis Lyle “Nick” Satterfield, 63, husband of Melissie Coleman Satterfield, passed away on Saturday, February 13, 2021, at Spartanburg Regional Medical Center, following a brief illness.

Nick was born in Greenwood on May 27, 1957, the son of the late Curtis Theron Satterfield and Billie Drake Satterfield.
